Items accepted for recycling:

- newspapers/newspaper inserts (clean & dry)
- Mixed paper, including junk mail/envelopes (cellophane windows okay), magazines/catalogs, wrapping paper (no foiled wrap)
- books (hardback & paperback)
- shredded paper
- telephone books
- #1 bottle plastic (as long as it is clear, not white or black)
- #2 plastic
- aluminum cans (no household aluminum)
- tin cans (labels okay, but please rinse)
- cardboard (clean, dry and flattened), fiberboard (cereal, beverage, pasta boxes, etc.), brown paper bags/ feed or seed bags without plastic liners
- white office/school paper; staples okay)
- used oil filters
- Styrofoam in blocks, no thin food or drink containers
